1. About the Website

- (a) The Website, www.ntrustus.com.au (**Website**), provides you with information and access to register and subscribe to the nTrustus Complaints and Compliments Portal (**Services**).
- (b) The Website is operated by nTrustus Pty Ltd, ACN 665 094 306. Access to and use of the Website, or any of its associated products or Services, is provided by nTrustus Pty Ltd. Please read these terms and conditions (**Terms**) carefully. Using, browsing and reading the Website signifies that you have read, understood and agree to be bound by the Terms. If you disagree with the Terms, you must cease using the Website or any Services.
- (c) nTrustus Pty Ltd reserves the right to review and change any of the Terms by updating this page at its sole discretion. When nTrustus Pty Ltd updates the Terms, it will use reasonable endeavours to provide you with notice of updates to the Terms. Any changes to the Terms take immediate effect from the date of their publication. Before you continue, we recommend you keep a copy of the Terms for your records.

2. Acceptance of the Terms

You accept the Terms by remaining on the Website. Where the option is available in the user interface, you may also accept the Terms by clicking to accept or agree to the Terms.

3. About the Service

- (b) Free and subscription accounts are currently offered. You acknowledge and agree that the provided accounts and account features may change from time to time and may be governed by separate terms that apply specifically to the account.
- (c) Where special account-specific terms apply, you will be informed and must accept those terms before you are given such an account. To avoid doubt, these Terms apply unless otherwise agreed or amended by account-specific terms.
- (d) Some accounts may be governed by a separate Software Licensing Agreement with nTrustus Pty Ltd, which may amend the terms of use. To avoid doubt, these Terms apply unless otherwise agreed or amended by the terms of an applicable Software Licensing Agreement.





4. Acceptable use of the Service

- (a) nTrustus Complaints and Compliments Platform, its related features, and its website must only be used lawfully. nTrustus Pty Ltd reserves the right to suspend, cancel, or otherwise deny access to users and accounts who use the service:

7. Participant Registration to use the Service

10. Refund Policy

14. Termination of Contract

- (a) The Terms will continue to apply until you or nTrustus Pty Ltd terminates them as set out below.
- (b) If you want to terminate the Terms, you may do so by:
 - (i) not renewing the Subscription before the end of the Subscription Period;
 - (ii) providing nTrustus Pty Ltd with 14 days' notice of your intention to terminate and
 - (iii) closing your accounts for all of your services, where nTrustus Pty Ltd has made this option available to you.
- (c) Any notices pursuant to Clause 13.2 above should be sent, in writing, to nTrustus Pty Ltd via the 'Contact Us' link on our homepage.
- (d) nTrustus Pty Ltd may, at any time, terminate the Terms with you if:
 - (i) you do not renew the Subscription at the end of the Subscription Period;
 - (ii) you have breached any provision of the Terms or intend to breach any provision;
 - (iii) nTrustus Pty Ltd is required to do so by law;
 - (iv) the provision of the Services to you by nTrustus Pty Ltd is no longer commercially viable in the opinion of nTrustus Pty Ltd.
- (e) Subject to local applicable laws, nTrustus Pty Ltd, reserves the right to discontinue or cancel your Subscription or Account at any time and may suspend or deny, in its sole discretion, your access to all or any portion of the Website or the Services without notice if you breach any provision of the Terms or any applicable law or if your conduct impacts nTrustus Pty Ltd's name or reputation or violates the rights of those of another party.

15. Indemnity

You agree to indemnify nTrustus Pty Ltd, its affiliates, employees, agents, contributors, third-party content providers and licensors from and against:

- (a) all actions, suits, claims, demands, liabilities, costs, expenses, loss and damage (including legal fees on a full indemnity basis) incurred, suffered or arising out of or in connection with your content:
- (b) any direct or indirect consequences of you accessing, using or transacting on the Website or attempts to do so; and/or
- (c) any breach of the Terms.





16. Dispute Resolution

Compulsory

(a) If a dispute arises out of or relates to the Terms, either party may not commence any Tribunal or Court proceedings in relation to the dispute, unless the following clauses have been complied with (except where urgent interlocutory relief is sought).

Notice

(b) A party to the Terms claiming a dispute (**Dispute**) has arisen under the Terms must give written notice to the other party detailing the nature of the dispute, the desired outcome and the action required to settle the Dispute.

Resolution

- (c) On receipt of that notice (**Notice**) by that other party, the parties to the Terms (**Parties**) must:
 - (i) Within 28 days of the Notice, endeavour in good faith to resolve the Dispute expeditiously by negotiation or such other means upon which they may mutually agree;
 - (ii) If, for any reason whatsoever, 28 days after the date of the Notice, the Dispute has not been resolved, the Parties must either agree upon the selection of a mediator or request that a mediation body appoint an appropriate mediator can be used to assist the parties to come to a mutual agreement through non-judicial means. Here is a list of accredited mediation bodies in Australia msb.org.au/msb- member-list. Common choices include the Australian Mediation Association and the Resolution Institute.;
 - (iii) The Parties are equally liable for the fees and reasonable expenses of a mediator and the cost of the mediation venue and, without limiting the foregoing, undertake to pay any amounts requested by the mediator as a precondition to the mediation commencing. The Parties must each pay their own costs associated with the mediation;
 - (iv) The mediation will be held in Sydney, Australia.

Confidential

(d) All communications concerning negotiations made by the Parties arising out of and in connection with this dispute resolution clause are confidential and, to the greatest extent possible, must be treated as "without prejudice" negotiations for applicable laws of evidence.

Termination of Mediation:

(e) If two months have elapsed after the start of a mediation of the Dispute and the Dispute has not been resolved, either Party may ask the mediator to terminate the mediation, and the mediator must do so.





17. Venue and Jurisdiction

The Services offered by nTrustus Pty Ltd are intended to be viewed by residents of Australia. In the event of any dispute arising out of or in relation to the Website, you agree that the exclusive venue for resolving any dispute shall be in the courts of New South Wales.

18. Governing Law

The laws of New South Wales govern the Terms. Any dispute, controversy, proceeding or claim of whatever nature arising out of or in any way relating to the Terms and the rights created hereby shall be governed, interpreted and construed by, under and under the laws of New South Wales, Australia, without reference to conflict of law principles, notwithstanding mandatory rules. The validity of this governing law clause is not contested. The Terms shall be binding to the benefit of the parties and their successors and assigns.

19. Severance

If any part of these Terms is found to be void or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, that part shall be severed, and the rest of the Terms shall remain in force.
